He explained that we have managed to keep the rate low over the years and that surrounding districts have already moved to the maximum rate allowable. Further, due to the expected growth in the community and the necessary purchase of a new ladder truck will require additional funds to provide adequate services. Richard Beard moved to set the 2023 tax rate for real estate, personal property, and watercraft at 10 cents per \$100. Mark Gardner seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

Chairman Deibel directed Laura Stoess to complete the necessary forms for setting the tax rate and publish notification in the Oldham Era. A public meeting will be held in September for anyone wishing to comment on the tax rate.

Chairman Deibel advised that representatives from the District will appear before Fiscal Court on September 5 to present the budget. Although an appearance is not required, Chairman Deibel desires to continue to foster positive public relations; therefore, Chief Blakely, Major Nelson, Eddie Turner, and Dennis Deibel will plan to present.
