- Must be 150 Hour Certified Firefighter for a minimum of 4 years
- Must be IFSAC Certified Firefighter 1 & 2 (Including Haz-Mat Awareness & Ops)
- Must be IFSAC and Kentucky Fire Instructor 1 for a minimum of 2 years
